
Decision Rule and Applying the Guard Band Rule



Testing laboratories of TÜV Rheinland InterCert Kft. apply the **Zero Guard Band** rule unless otherwise required by the standard or requested by the customer. The Guard band rule applied in the decision making (decision rule) is conveyed to the customer during the application review regardless of if it is when measurement uncertainty is required or not. Should the measurement uncertainty be used to provide guard band, these values will be declared in the test report according to *MS-0041609 Measurement Uncertainty* and *MS-0002592 Preparation of Test Reports*.


For the Zero Guard Band rule, the measurement uncertainty is not considered and will also not be declared in the Test Report.
