TÜV Rheinland now offers testing and certification for smart home products according to the MATTER communication standard. MATTER was released by the Connectivity Standards Alliance (formerly Zigbee Alliances) and is the first international standard that defines uniform, cross-national framework conditions for smart home products.

WHAT IS MATTER 1.0

Matter is one protocol to connect compatible devices and systems with one another; with a new approach to create a rapid, transformative impact on the market.

- Industry–unifying standard is a promise of reliable, secure connectivity.
- Offers a familiar and consistent setup flow to make onboarding simple, reliable, and secure.

With a unifying standard, it allows consumers to connect smart devices to multiple apps and ecosystems locally, securely, and simultaneously. 
